2009 CATEGORIES

- _____ Home of the Year 3,500 square feet and under
Minimum of 4 rooms, cannot cross enter into individual categories
- _____ Home of the Year 3,500 square feet and over
Minimum of 4 rooms, cannot cross enter into individual categories
- _____ Living Room / Great Room
- _____ Dining Room
- _____ Kitchen
- _____ Bedroom
- _____ Bath
- _____ Special Space- *Any area not covered in above categories. i.e. office, wine room, gym, closets includes media room, home theater, loggia, library. **WE HAVE ADDED BOATS AND PLANES.***
- _____ Rising Star *In business no earlier than 2005. Portfolio submission of 3 projects with at least one professionally photographed.*
- _____ Peoples Choice Award *Designers must submit one image from their entries for the Online Contest. It will be a popularity contest and people can vote as often as they want.*

- Project is no longer required to be located in Orange County as long as the designer is an **active** member of the Orange County chapter of ASID.
- Only one project per entry to be submitted.
- Project must be completed no earlier than 2007.
- No Design House or Home Tour rooms will be accepted.
- Projects may be published but not within the past year in Orange Coast magazine.
- Designer may not enter more than 3 categories and no more than 2 entries per category. Maximum of 6 entries total.
- A category needs to have at least 4 entries to be considered a contest. If the category does not meet the minimum entries the designer will be given the option to withdraw the entry with a full refund, or the entry may be placed in the special space category.
- Designer must submit a color head shot with entry. This photo does not need to be professionally photographed. These will be used during the awards ceremony. Should the

designer win an award, a professional head shot must be submitted to Orange Coast Magazine for publishing.

- One photo per entry must be high resolution. The other 2 photos may be non-professional photos. Designers are also encouraged to include before shots.
- **Home of the Year** requires a minimum of 3 high resolution photos with a maximum of 10 photos overall including non-professional photos.
- Include floor plan and if possible, elevations. Please include scale. Please remove your name or company name from title block. **PLEASE DO NOT PROVIDE FULL SCALE DRAWINGS.**
- CD's will not be returned. You will have 30 days to pick up entry binders from the ASID-OC office. You will be notified by e-mail when they are available for pick up. After 30 days the entries will be discarded.
- Your name or company name **cannot** appear anywhere in the entry except for your signature on this form.
- You must complete and submit all forms for this entry. Entries missing forms or items will be disqualified.
- All release forms must be signed.
- Please include a business card with entry.
- Designer must have the permission from the client to use photos of their project for possible publication.
- **Entries must be turned to the ASID-OC no later than 4:00pm Friday, August 7, 2009. Late entries will not be accepted.**

PHOTOGRAPHY REQUIREMENTS

To maintain the reproduction quality standards of Orange Coast Magazine, photography submitted for the Competition **MUST** adhere to the following formats or the entry may be disqualified.

- ◆ We request that all entries include digital images on the CD provided. A minimum of 3 images must be submitted. These images must be of different angles of the space being submitted. Of the 3 images, one image must be a 300 dpi resolution professional photo with an image size of 8" X 10" and a minimum of 15 megabytes. The other two images can be digital photos. If available, please submit before photos.
For the Home of the Year Category the requirements are a minimum of 3 images and a 10 maximum. Of the 10 possible images, three must be of 300 dpi resolution professional photos with an image size of 8" X 10" and a minimum of 15 megabytes. The other possible 7 images can be digital photos.
- ◆ Include photographer's credit on the back of each photo. Please do NOT include your name.
- ◆ CDs will NOT be returned, please submit copies.
- ◆ Designers assume the responsibility to obtain rights for Orange Coast Magazine to publish any photograph submitted for the ASID/OC Design Awards. A photo release from the designer, photographer and home owner must be submitted. Winners will be required to submit a set of photos on a CD with each photo clearly labeled with the Designer's name and Room name for Orange Coast Magazine to publish.

Here are some items to consider when submitting for competition:

- ◆ Photography submissions that do not adhere to the above guidelines may not be published.
- ◆ Photos that would include any of the following examples may not be published:
 - Poorly lighted, out-of-focus, high grain images.

- Low-resolution digital images at 300dpi resolution. (File sizes smaller than 10 megabytes.)

Photography Requirements Continued

- Computer Ink jet printed photos.
 - Matte color prints or Polaroid© prints.
- ◆ Details and vignettes are appreciated. These images could be used in the Contest Issues and/or other future feature issues.
 - ◆ To be considered for the a cover, vertical photos should be included.

Orange Coast Magazine publishes only high-quality photography and strongly suggests that Designers hire a professional photographer to produce images for their Design Award Entry. The following photographers are available for hire on a freelance basis. You may consider hiring one of these professionals, or any other photographer you choose as long as the format standards outlined above are fully satisfied.

1. Complete the following:
 - Entry Form
 - Project Information Sheet
 - provide CD with high resolution photographs
 - provide room photographs including minimums required by each category placed in protective sleeves
 - provide a color head shot of yourself
 - sign all release forms
 - sign requirements form
 - provide maximum 11"x 17" reduced floor plan
 - resource form
 - provide a business card
2. Completed entry MUST be submitted in a black paper report cover, letter size with 3 metal prong fasteners. Office Depot has them. The item number is 631-335.
3. NOTE: Keep it simple. This is not a portfolio piece. Do not put your name on the photographs.
4. Completed entry must be postmarked August 7, 2009 or delivered to the ASID OC Office BY 4:00pm on August 7, 2009.
5. You will receive a confirmation by e-mail that your entry and payment information has been received.
6. You will receive your gala invitation and an RSVP card that will indicate that one ticket is paid for. That RSVP must be returned in the envelope to the
